





- 6. RoofMaster Blade, Example Shown Marley Mendip





Important Information



Warning

Constructed from aluminium and steel, the ROOFMASTER must not be used during thunderstorms or in proximity to electrical power lines or unidentified cables. A thorough risk assessment must be completed before starting each job.



How to store your blades

The Scraper Blades are constructed from 304 stainless steel. It is imperative to ensure they are dry and thoroughly cleaned prior to storage. Inadequate maintenance may lead to the accumulation of corrosive substances, thereby accelerating surface wear. The blades should be wiped down with a soft cloth and a mild detergent to eliminate residues that could induce corrosion.
